**Description:**

Attractive antique map of Nijmegen on the River Waal in the Netherlands. The map, which is oriented so that south is towards the upper part of the work, shows the city as a series of fortifications without significant detail inside the city.

Nijmegen is the oldest city in the Netherlands, which has been recognized since the Roman era. As a border town on the edge of the Republic of United Provinces, it was besieged many times even following its final capture from the Spanish Empire in 1591. The town's fortifications would be demolished in 1874, when the Franco-Prussian War made it evident that such defenses were no longer useful.
