Description:

Highly detailed antique woodcut bird's-eye view of Rouffach, a town in eastern France known for its Alsatian wines. The view shows the city and its surroundings in great detail, with fields, buildings, churches, and a castle all depicted in Sebastian Munster's classic gothic style.

Looming above the city is the Chateau d'Isenbourg, which has now been converted to a guesthouse. While the city is formed in a curious U shape, it is not bounded by a river as shown on the view. The city is located nearby to the Rhine.

The view includes an elaborate title banner above the town. This originally appeared in Munster's *Cosmographia*, one of the most influential geographical works of the 16th century, first published in 1544.

Detailed Condition:

Small amount of toning and staining at the centerfold - confined to top and bottom blank margins.
