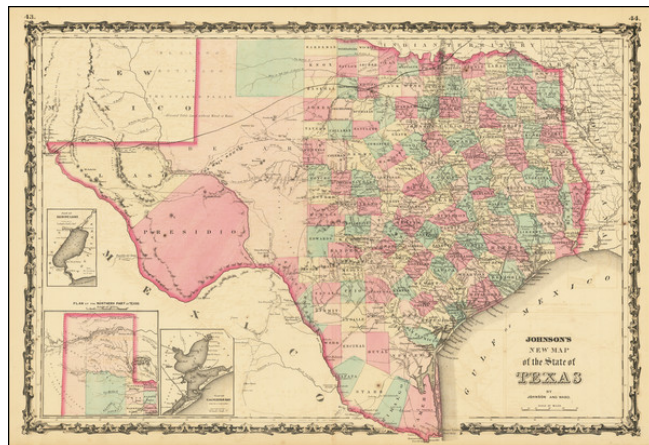

A striking large format map of Texas, colored by counties, with large insets of the northern panhandle, Galveston and Sabine Lake.

The map reflects the relative expansion of the Counties of Texas, with more or less the current configurations in the east but overall, very few in the west. The map shows towns, railroads (actual and proposed), stations, lakes, rivers, and important early roads and explorers routes. Some of the Military Outposts and Indian information is also shown.

A terrific map of Texas during the Civil War from a leading cartographic publisher of the era.
