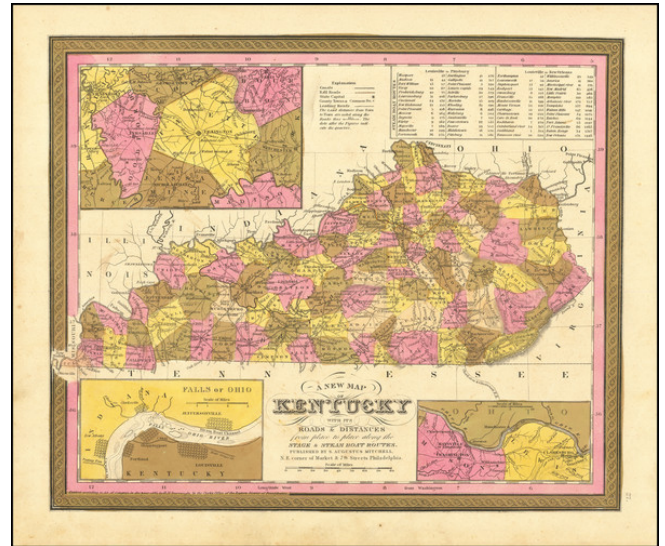

First Mitchell edition of this detailed and interesting map of Kentucky, hand-colored by county and showing towns, rivers, lakes, railroads, roads, distances, forts, etc.

Tables of steamboat routes and distances. Large insets of the Lexington area, the Washington and Clarksburg area, and the Falls of Ohio, showing Louisville and its environs and the Louisville and Portland Canal bypassing the falls.

S. Augustus Mitchell's pre-1850 maps have become very scarce.

The county configuration suggests that this is a 1846 map, however, the 1847 Mitchell does not show Fulton County (created in 1846) leading to some confusion about dating.
