#### *San Francisco's Finest One Day Trip -- The Crookedest Railroad in the World*

Striking image of the San Francisco Bay area, looking over top of Mount Tamalpais from the northwest.

The view extends from the Farrallon Islands, Mt. Hamilton and the San Joaquin Valley to Mt. Shasta and Lake Lagunita, centered on San Francisco Bay.

The focal point of the image is the trip from San Francisco to Mt. Tamalpais, first by Ferry to Sausalito, then by rail to the Observatory at Mt. Tamalpais, via "the crookedest railroad in the world", with 281 curves.
