This is one of the most interesting and highly detailed regional maps of the period. Notes abound on the map, describing the tides, agriculture, and terrain of the region.

This map first appeared in Vandermaelen's remarkable six-volume *Atlas Universel*. Should the many sheets of this text be combined as globe gores, the viewer could form an immense globe. This atlas was the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale.
