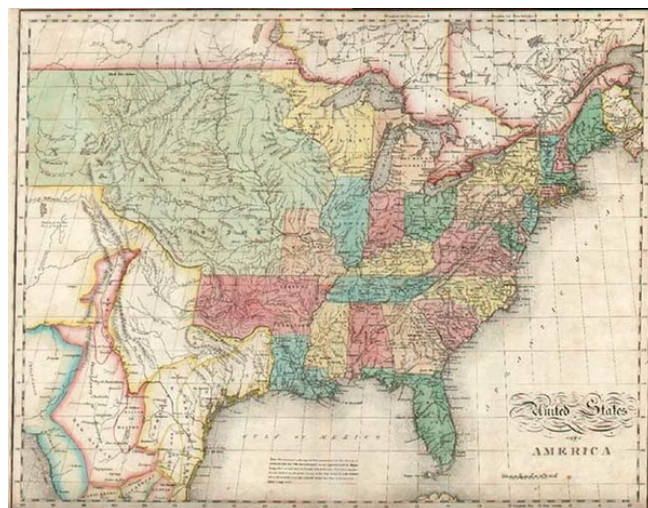

Nice example of Melish's map of the United States, which appeared in the Lavoisonne and Carey & Lea Atlases in the late 1810s and early 1820s. Includes notes on Lewis & Clark, a massive Missouri Territory, double wide Arkansas, early Michigan Territory and Northwest Territory. A number of Western Forts are shown in the Mississippi Valley Texas is named, with a badly mislocated Galvezton and a handful of other placenames, including Ft. Matagorda. The map shows towns, roads, Indian placenames, river and a handful of early and not always accurate exploration notes. A nice example of a map often found in poor condition.
