

Scarce map of Colorado Territory, showing sixteen counties and a large Indian Reserve. The reserve is divided into Cheyenne and Arapahoe tribes.

Extensive watershed information and mountains are shown in hachure. Locates all mining communities, forts, railroads, and more.

The map is accompanied by a decent example of Hollister's *The Mines of Colorado*, published in 1867. It provides a view of the geography, geology, climate, and agriculture etc. Extensive information on over 165 mining enterprises.
