### Description:

Nice example of the Latin edition of Hartmann Schedel's incunable view of Constantinople Schedel's *Liber Chronicum*, perhaps the single most influential secular illustrated book of the 15th Century and one of the landmark printed works of the 15th Century.

Schedel included two views of Constantinople, including this single page view showing the capture of the city by the Turks in 1453 and a larger double page view. The two are the earliest obtainable views of the City and the only 15th Century views realistically available to collectors.

### Detailed Condition:

Soiling and dampstaining, primarily in margins.
