

The map includes a large inset of San Francisco Bay, attractively colored according to the county. Oakland, Sausalito, Berkeley, San Rafael, Palo Alto, and many more towns and cities are marked. This is the best large format map of San Francisco to appear in an early 20th-century commercial atlas.

The detail on the map is extensive and attractive. Parks are given a bright green color, while the rest of the city is shown in an attractive pink. Many streets and features are named. The city is shown having just rebuilt itself following the disastrous earthquake of 1905.
