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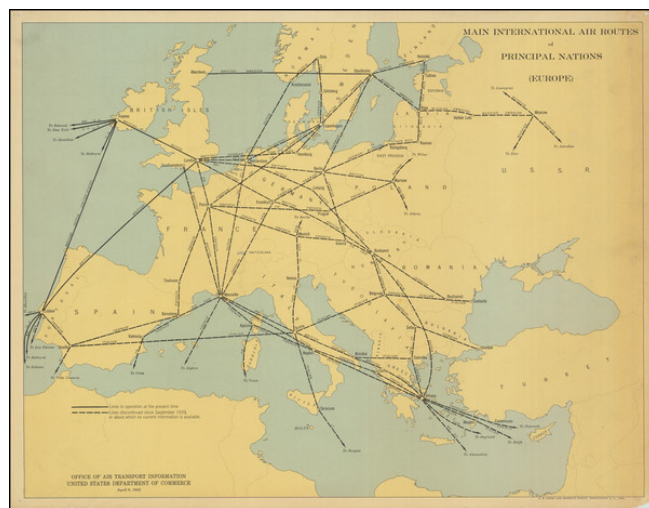

Interesting map of the operational and discontinued main air routes of major European countries in 1943 from the Office of Air Transport Information, a precursor to the Federal Aviation Authority. The routes include the many refueling stops needed for air travel at the time.
