Charming original antique map of the region of southern Burgundy, in eastern France. Bounded by the course of the Loire River in the west, and the French Alps in the east, this map presents a detailed look at this region famous for its wines.

Numerous cities are shown on the map, including Dijon, Besancon, Nevers, Geneva, and Lausanne. Mountains, forests, and other features are shown pictorially.

The map was published in 1648 by the great French cartographer Nicolas Sanson, who was the royal geographer to the king. His maps follow a delicate French School style, presenting a detailed look at the regions they show but preserving a pleasant simplicity to the image.
