Great antique map of Gascogny and southwestern France, showing the region between the Charente-Maritime coastline to the Languedoc in the east. The map was published in 1650 by Nicolas Sanson, one of the leading French cartographers of the 17th century.

The map is highly detailed, naming many cities such as Bordeaux, Bayonne, Toulouse, Agen, Albi, and Foix. The Pyrenees and their foothills are shown pictorially. The Atlantic is named "The large sea."
