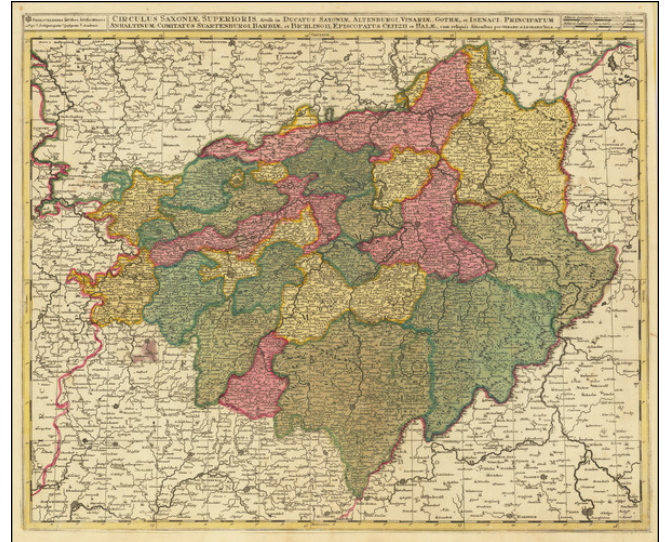

Nice example of Valk's highly detailed regional map of eastern Germany, extending from Prague and Dresden to Cassel and Hildesheim, centered on Erfurt, Altenburg, Leipsing, and Weimar. This map was published by Valk in Amsterdam at the end of the 17th century.

The map is extremely detailed, showing cities, towns, rivers, lakes, counties, and more. The Electorate of Saxony, at the time, was part of the Holy Roman Empire and predominantly Lutheran.
