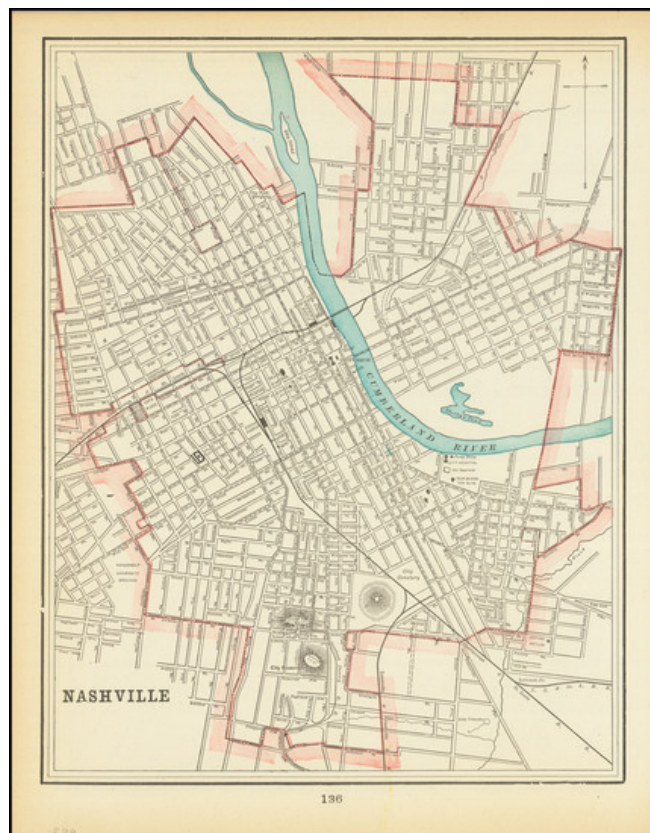

#### *The First Atlas Map of Nashville*

Fine example of George Cram's map of Nashville, the earliest separate atlas map of Nashville to appear in a commercial atlas.

Centered on the Cumberland River, the map includes street names, major public buildings and early railroad lines.

The Vanderbilt University Grounds (founded 1873) are shown, although no sign of neighboring Belmont University (founded in 1890).
