A striking large format map of Texas, colored by counties, with large insets of the northern panhandle, Galveston and Sabine Lake. The map reflects the relative expansion of the Counties of Texas, with more or less the current configurations in the east but overall very few in the West. The map shows towns, railroads (actual and proposed), stations, lakes, rivers, and important early roads and explorers routes. Some of the Miltary Outposts and Indian Indian information is also shown. Early states of the Johnson map of Texas are now increasingly difficult to obtain, especially the pre-Civil War editions. A nice example, which has been archivally backed on the verso to support a fold split. A bit of toning. Normally, a \$400.00 map.
