



Hand written letter from Henry Tanner to Gales & Seaton, publishers of the National Intelligencer, seeking to have a review of his newly published wall map of the world published in their newspaper.

The letter provides a fascinating insight into the (self-) promotion of cartographic works by America's leading mapmaker, Henry Schenk Tanner. <u>Tanner's 1831 wall map of the World</u>, entitled *A New and Authentic Map of the World Embracing all the Recent Discoveries, and exhibiting particularly the Nautical researches of the most Distinguished Circumnavigators, From the Latest & Best Authorities; With Numerous Corrections & Additions,* is one Tanner's rarest works.
