

Highly detailed map of the region from Vandermaelen's Atlas Universel, the first atlas to systematically map the world in uniform scale. The map is a testament to the phenomenal effort Vandermaelen undertook to compile contemporary and highly detailed information from all parts of the world. This map shows counties, towns, roads, rivers, mountains, Indian Tribes and Villages, Forts, lakes, and other geographical details. Mississippi is largely unsettled Indian Lands. The region North of Louisiana and East of the Mississippi River is controlled by Indians and is largely uncharted. Alabama and Western Tennessee are also very primitive. Covers all of Santa Rosa Bay in Western Florida. A fine example of a scarce and highly desireable map, for which only 300 examples were reportedly issued.
