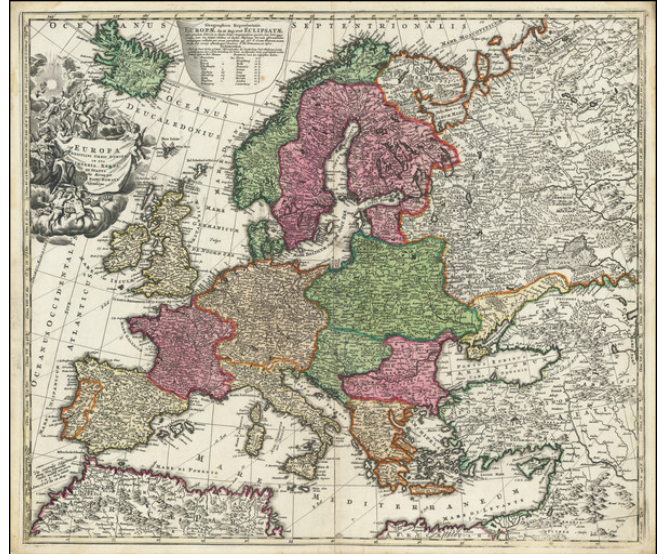

Scarce map of Europe by JB Homann, published in connection with the Eclipse May 12, 1706.

The map illustrates the progress of the eclipse, also noting the places where there would be a total eclipse and a partial eclipse, along with the times (in minutes) for the length of the eclipse. For example, Zurich would experience a 4 minute total eclipse, while Paris would experience an partial eclipse of 10 5/6 minutes.

The information for the map was calcuated by Johann Gabriel Doppelmayr.
