Two highly detailed overlapping sea chart, which combine to cover the entirety of Thames Estuary. based upon the surveys of Captn. F. Bullock, R.N. (1844-49).

Extending from the mouth of the Thames to Margate and Ramsgate in the southeast and the Naze Tower in the north, the charts include thousands of soundings, sailing directions, shallows, light houses, floating lights and other details.

Within the estuary, we also note that among the dozens of buoys shown, many are described based upon coloration, including black, white, black & white checked, and red & white stripes.

A significant amount of detail is also shown on land, including buildings, roads and topographical features.
