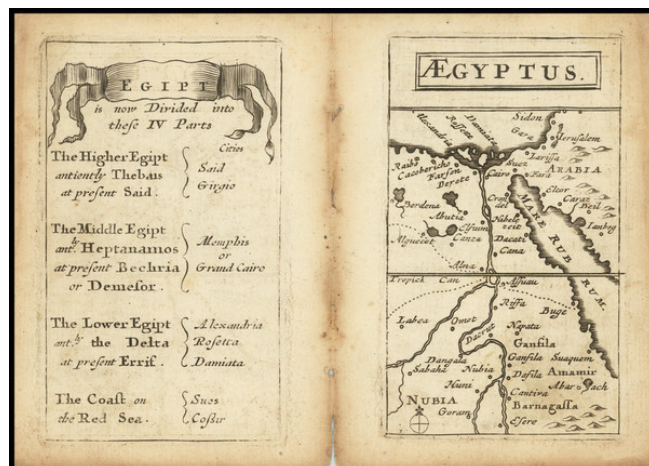

This is a rare early miniature English map of Egypt, which was published in John Seller's *Atlas Minimus or a Book of Geography Shewing all the Empires, Monarchies, Kingdoms, Regions, Dominions Principalities and Countries of the World*.

This finely detailed map offers a wealth of information about the topography and geography of Egypt, including the locations of major cities, rivers, and mountain ranges.

Seller's *Atlas Minimus* is considered one of the rarest and most sought-after miniature atlases, and this map of Egypt is a notable addition to the collection. The last complete example of the atlas to appear at auction was the Wardington copy in 2006, which sold for about \$22,000.

As such, this map represents a valuable and significant piece of cartographic history, providing a fascinating glimpse into the early exploration and mapping of the Egyptian landscape.
