Saucy Chief (aka Ga-hi-ge Wa-da-in-ga, or Playful Chief). Saucy Chief (1815-1901?) was purportedly the first Osage chief to express an intention "to walk in the way of the white man" - expressed by him to one of the early Agency superintendents.

A print of this photograph is in the Gilcrease Museum, and though the photographer remains unidentified, it is possibly Thomas M. Concannon.
