## One of the Earliest Obtainable Modern Maps of England

Finely colored example of Sebastian Munster's map of the British Isles, one of the earliest separately printed maps of the British Isles and a landmark in the cartographic landmark in the history of British maps.

First published by Sebastian Munster in his Geographia of 1540, the map is oriented with East at the top and extends to Edinburg in the North, also showing the East Coast of Ireland. A key in the upper left corner shows the English and Latin names for 17 major place names in England.

The map includes the Royal Standard at the top center and the Scottish flag at the lower left.
