Rare example of Finley's large format map of North America in pocket map format, folded into 6x4 inch leather folder with gilt embossed title on cover. Russian Possessions and a large 54 40 or fight border with the Russian Possessions dominate the map, a serious political statement for the period. The region of the Northwest bounded by Upper California and Russian Possessions is still Missouri Territory, and contains the best information from Lewis & Clark and the Hunt & Stuart expedition for Astoria, although the Oregon Trail is not yet shown. Excellent detail in the Rocky Mountains and Texas, which is shown as Intendency of San Luis Potosi. Galveston, Laredo, San Antonio, Mier, Revilla and Vicente appear on the Rio Grande. Notes of the Wako Indians, Cumanches Indians and Curancaways are also present in Texas. The US/Russia Border is settled by the Convention of April 1824. Many Indian Tribes throughout the West. A number of long mythical rivers in Upper California flow from the Great Basin to the Pacific. Double wide Arkansas Territory and large Northwest Territory. This is the first example of a large Finley Pocket Map of North America we have ever seen. The condition is near mint, with only the tiniest point fold wear. A
