

Nice showing streets, roads, parks, buildings, rail lines, bridges, race track, US Arsenal, and other interesting details. The map delimits Washington into four quadrants and shows important buildings in black. Neighboring Virginia is shown in pink.

This is a fine example of this highly detailed map, from *Rand McNally's Indexed Atlas of the World*, perhaps the best large format late 19th-century atlas published in America.
