

Description:

Survey map of Chelan National Forest, a year after Okanogan National Forest was transferred to it. In 1955, the name was reverted to Okanogan. Washington (now Mount Baker-Snoqualmie) and Colville National Forests are shown to the west and east, respectively.

This example shows the coverage of Yellow Pine, transitional coverage, and sub-alpine ecosystems. The owner seemed to think better of his survey and stopped part way through.
