

Description:

Aeronautical map of the area around Hungtze (Hongze) Lake, from Tsingtao (Qingdao) to the Yangtze River, including the cities of Yichow (Linyi), Tsining (Jining), Suchow (Xuzhou), Nanking (Nanjing). When this map was issued, this area was occupied by Japan.

Thick black dashed lines (in long-short-short or - -- dashes) mark provincial boundaries between Anhui, Jiangsu, Henan, and Shandong.

AtoNs (Aids to Navigation such as lighthouses, buoys, and beacons) have their lighting abbreviation—flashing (Fl.) and group flashing (Gp. Fl.).

Printed at the Survey of India Offices (H.L.O.) Probably produced in India in relation to Allied bombing campaigns against occupied China.

Detailed Condition:

Moderate foxing and wear along folds, including pinhole at central crossfold. Pen titling "Coast — Tsingtao to Yangtze" in bottom margin.
