Scarce example of the Frankfurt edition of Sanson's early regional map of the southern tip of South America, from P. de las Baixas and Port Desire in the east and the southern portion of Chile in the west, showing Magellanica in remarkable detail, including Staten land, Destroit de Browers, Cape Horn, Diego Ramirez, and many other points, capes, islands, straits, etc.

The map first appeared in Sanson's *L'Amerique en Plusieurs Cartes Nouvelles…* the third atlas to focus solely upon America in 1657.

This example is from Johann Zurner's Die Gantz Erd-Kugel, published in Frankfurt in 1679. The Zurner edition is the only edition to include the title in Spanish.
