

## **Description:**

Rare miniature map of the Middle Colonies, published in John Gibson's *Atlas Minimus*, the first miniature English Atlas to include a number or regional maps of the Colonies

While the focal point of the map is the Chesapeake and Delaware Bay regions, the map extends west to the confluence of the Ohio and Mississippi Rivers, with sparce interior details. A note in the interior states:

Pensilvania is a rich well peop'd & cultivat.d Province, produc'g Grain & Cattle of all kinds Timber Pot-ashes, Skin, Furs, &c. Virginia & Maryland produce Tobacco, which the former especially, raises in Such Plenty as to be able to furnish most Parts of Europe with it.

A terrific American Miniature Atlas map, which rarely appears on the market. This is one of the few works to include regional maps of the colonies at the time of the French & Indian War.
