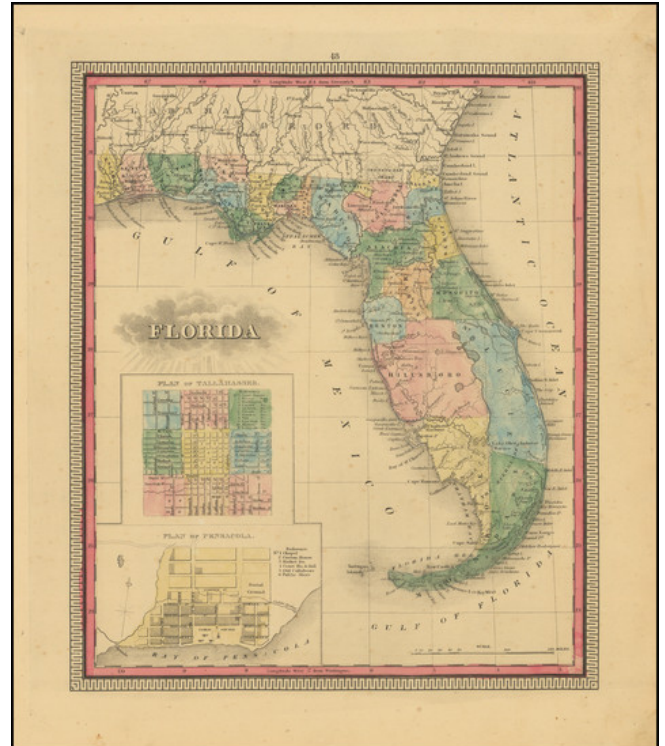

#### Description:

##### *The Rarest Atlas Map of the State of Florida*

Extremely rare map of Florida (in the year it became a state), published Tanner's *New General Atlas*, published in New York City by Tanner's Geographical Establishment, written and engraved by Joseph Perkins.

The map pre-dates the formation of Levy County (1845), Holmes County (1848) and Putnam County (1849).

Tanner's *New General Atlas* was issued following Tanner's sale of his *Universal Atlas* to Samuel August Mitchell. The *Universal Atlas*, which had been published in Philadelphia from 1836 to 1845. Tanner's *New General Atlas*, for which Anthony Finley was also a collaborator, is one of the rarest 19th Century American atlases.
