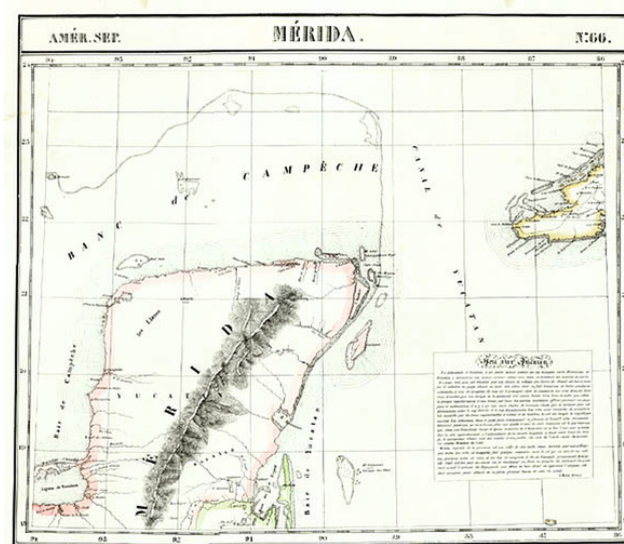

Highly detailed regional map, showing the Yucatan Peninsula from the Bay of Campeche and Lagunas de Terminos to the Bay du St. Espirt, Salamanca and the New River. Cozumel and Cancun are both named. Approximately 50 placenames in the Yucatan. The coverage of Cuba extends from Punta de Pierdras and Bay de la Guardia on the south side to the Sierra del Rosario and Ines Soto on the north side of the island. Approximately 30 placenames and roads are shown. From Vandermaelen's remarkable 6 volume atlas, which if combined as globe gores forms an immense globe. Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale.
