



This map offers a glance into the infrastructure and development of the city by illustrating neighborhoods of the area like Long Beach, Torrance, and part of Redondo Beach. These areas are shown with many roads and their classification (Heavy, medium, or light duty and unimproved) as well as the locations of newly built interstates and freeways.
