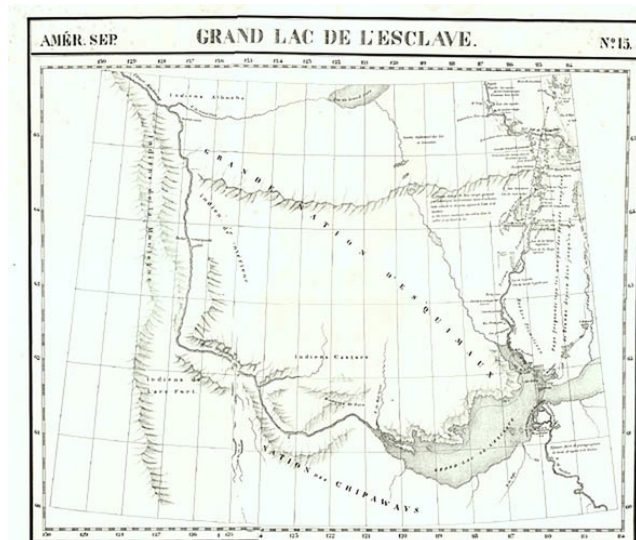

On the eastern portion of the map is a highly detailed account of the various Rivers and Portages North of Slave Lake, including details on the lengths of the portages, dates, the number of lakes encountered and many other wonderful details of the exploration of the region. A number of Forts are shown, including Ft. Providence, Resolution and l'Esclave. Various Indigenous Indian Tribes are also shown, including the Grand Nation of the Esquimaux, Nation Des Chippeways and the Castors and Athnachs, among others. A remarkable map. From Vandermaelen's remarkable 6 volume atlas, which if combined as globe gores forms an immense globe. Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale.
