Merian's edition of Blaeu's famous map of the World on Mercator's Projection. Shows an elongated NW Coastline culminating in a narrow strait (Anian) between Asia and America. California and the Sierra Nevadas are prominently named. A large southern land mass is named Magellanica. No Great Lakes. Australia is not yet present as a separate landmass. Narrow southern strait between the Atlantic and Pacific. The eastern coastline of North America is still very primitive. No Great Lakes. Overall a strong dark impression of this decorative map. Shirley #345, Plate 262. Attractively colored, with sea monsters, ships, compass roses, etc. The cartography of North America, Antarctica and the South Pacific are of great interest.
