A detailed map of Italy, including Sicily, Pantelleria, Sardinia, and Elba.

Corsica is also mapped, but in white, as is San Marino, not in the yellow indicating Italian holds. In the northeast, Italy's border extends to just east of the Natisone River and entirely west of the Soca River, with Istria entirely in the Dalmatia province of the Austro-Hungarian Empire. Livorno is labeled "Leghorn", a British name for the city derived from its Genoese name, Ligorna.

Battlegrounds are marked with crossed swords and the date, showing the locations of victories by the French Republic, under Napoleon Bonaparte, in 1796 at Mondovi, Lodi, Mantua, and Dego, in 1800 at Marengo, and a 1799 loss under General Barthélemy Catherine Joubert at Novi.
