

## **Description:**

Flawless example of the highly detailed map, with insets of the Gold Region (centered on Cabarus and Stanley County) and the Neuse River and New Berne. Shows towns, roads, railroads, rivers, mountains, lakes, creeks, canals, etc. A clean fresh example with wide margins. SA Mitchell acquired the rights to Tanner's Universal Atlas in 1846 and issued the first edition of his Universal Atlas the same year. SA Mitchell editions were issued until 1850, when Thomas Cowperthwait & Company took over publication. Mitchell editions are becoming increasingly rare on the market and the separate maps are now increasingly difficult to obtain. A nice example, with red lines showing railroads and black lines for canals.
