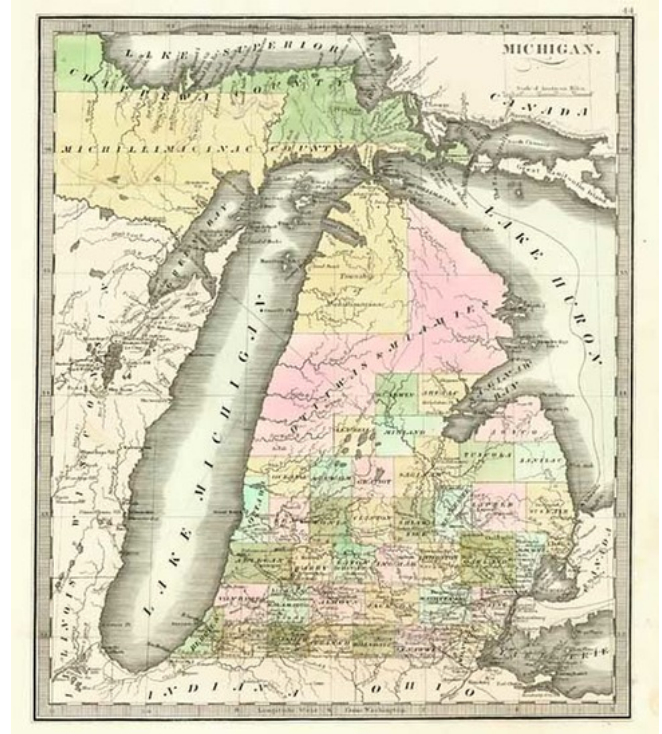

Chipewa and Michilimackinac County appear in the Upper Peninsula, and the Township of Michillimacinac is present. The Ottawas & Miamies dominate the northern part of the state. The Boundary Line established by the Saginaw Treaty is shown, A number of Indian Villages are named. The map includes towns, early counties, roads, rivers, lakes, forts, and other notes.
