

Carey published his American Atlas in 1795, which became the first folio atlas published in America. He issued later General Atlases in 1796 and after. In 1814, he became the first American publisher to offer hand coloring. Highly detailed map, showing towns, rivers, roads, counties, colleges, mills, forts and other details. An essential map for New Hampshire collectors. A fine example, with nice wide margins and no paper flaws.
