

Insets of Quebec City, Fort Dauphine, the Atlantic Ocean, and a Plan of City and Port of Louisbourg appear on this chart. The Louisbourg and Quebec insets each contain a key to greater detail. Although uncolored, the cartouche is quite decorative showing a coastal battle scene. This chart was based on Bellin's original published in 1744. Trimmed by binder into neat line along left margin.
