## **Description:**

Nice separately issued example of Melish's map of the United States. Includes notes on Lewis & Clark, a massive Missouri Territory, early Michigan Territory and Northwest Territory. A number of Western Forts are shown in the Mississippi Valey Texas is named, with a badly mislocated Galveston and a handful of other placenames, including Ft. Matagorda. The map shows towns, roads, Indian placenames, river and a handful of early and not always accurate exploration notes. Melish's maps are highly coveted, especially the separately issued versions of the map. this unusual example was entered according to act of Congress 10th July 1818 and Published by Murray Draper Fairman & Co. of Philadelphia. One of the earliest examples of this map which we have seen to date, with Illiniois still pushed off the lake with tortured path to include Chicago. Some minor and not all together good repairs on the verso in the upper and lower left corners, but easily reversable. But for the repair problems, a \$2000.00 map.
