The map is drawn largely from Carey's map by Samuel Lewis, issued the prior year. An excellent topographical map, showing the counties, boundaries, principal towns, mountains, rivers, islands and many other details. John Reid's American Atlas was the second folio sized atlas published in the US. Reid's atlas was originally issued to accompany Winterbotham's *Historical, Geographical, Commercial and Philosophical View of the United States*. Toning and loss of image at the right side of the map, but not significant.
